MSP® Managing Successful Programmes Practitioner Course

Audience

Personnel requiring an in-depth understanding of MSP, particularly current or prospective programme managers.

Objective

To understand the benefits provided by programme management and the specifics of the MSP principles and processes

Topics

- Identify the aim of the programme and envisaged benefits to the organisation
- Define the programme and specify how the organisation will be different afterwards
- Establish the programme Governance processes
- Keep up to date information which tracks the continually changing environment
- Monitor and co-ordinate the projects within a programme to a successful conclusion
- Manage the transition between the 'old' and 'new' ways of working.

- Close the programme and ensure the 'end goal' has been achieved

The same basic course is presented to all levels of delegates. Not everyone wishes to undertake the accreditation examinations but simply to gain an understanding of the fundamental principles of programme management.

Duration

4.5 days in the classroom plus 6-8 hours of independent study between days 4 and 5. Full days run 9.00am to 4.30pm. Half day runs 9.00am to midday. Morning, afternoon tea and lunch will be provided on full days.

Pre-Course Preparation

Approximately 2 hours of reading from the course text book and case study is recommended to delegates before the course commences.

Examination

The Foundation examination will take place on the morning of day 4 and runs for 1 hour. The trainer will mark the examinations and provide your result at the conclusion of the course. The Practitioner examination will take place on the morning of the last day and runs for 2.5 hours. Exams will be marked by APMG Australasia and results will be available within 2 weeks.

Pre-Requisites

There are no pre-requisites to join the course however a pass in the Foundation exam is required before attempting the Practitioner exam.
